



Off the streets and on to life.

Quad A For Kids is looking for **TEACHERS** for our after-school programs. Quad A For Kids maintains a ratio of **10:1 Students under the age of 10 per adult** and a ratio of **15:1 Students between the ages of 10 and 13 per adult**.

Program Description: Quad A for Kids is a comprehensive after-school program serving 350 elementary students in grades 1-8 operating five days per week, three hours per day. The program focuses on developing the whole child by involving them in a wide variety of arts, athletic, and life skills activities in which key academic skills in the areas of reading, writing and math are integrated into the curriculum. High interest academic activities are project-based, emphasize higher level thinking skills and are strength-based rather than deficit based in nature. Additionally, the program provides homework assistance. Recent research conclusively shows that after-school programs that focus on the person and social development of children in a sequential, active, focused, and explicit way produces the best results in all areas of child development including academics. Teacher and Teacher Assistants are expected to integrate the PBIS program into its daily curriculum.

Program Duration: Program runs from September through May. **ALL STAFF** members must complete mandatory training in September and throughout the program duration as required.

Description: **Position:** Work schedule ranges from 1 to 19 hours per week. Teachers engage in activities and projects for groups of elementary school-age children enrolled in the after - school program. Ensures the safety of the children enrolled and monitors them during play activities. Teachers implement curriculum focused on developmental directives and incorporates student-driven discovery learning. Multidisciplinary approach with reading, writing, math, science, and social studies knowledge and skills incorporated into hands-on, high-interest activities. **Arts, Athletic and Life Skills Activities:** Do you have a special talent or interest that you would like to share with kids? Cooking, robotics, line dancing, chess, stepping, martial arts? The list is endless! The only limitation is your imagination!

Minimum Qualifications: Minimum of two years of college preferred and one year of relevant work experience.

Special Requirements: Applicants are required to complete a TB test, criminal background check and a check of the Child Protective Services Registry to the satisfaction of the employer.

Preferred Qualifications: Associates' Degree and one year of relevant experience with early childhood and/ or school aged children, recreation, and classroom or instructional training. Training should be equivalent to the completion of two years of study and training at an accredited four-year college or university with major coursework in early childhood, elementary education, nursing, recreation, or a related field.

Selection Process: Selection process includes application and interview. **ALL APPLICANTS** must submit and pass background checks and medical clearance for employment.
